This program will cost \$11,635.00 if completed within normal time. There may be additional costs for living expenses. These costs were accurate at the time of posting, but may have changed.

DESCRIPTION OF TOTAL PROGRAM COSTS:

- Tuition: \$10,000
 - Fees: \$ 235 (\$120 due 1st module; \$115 due 3rd module)
 - Estimated cost for books: \$ 1,400 (due at the beginning of school)
- Total: \$11,635

DESCRIPTION OF MISCELLANEOUS EXPENSES

- Administration fee- A \$100 nonrefundable fee to help defray the fixed costs of CSOR for reserving an academic position for the student.
- ID Badge Replacement: A \$10.00 replacement charge will be required for a lost or stolen badge.
- Autopsy fee- \$40.00
- Other expenses: basic calculator
- American Registry for Radiologic Technologist (ARRT) Exam Fee- \$200.00
- Texas Medical Board (TMB) License fee-\$80.00 to be paid with TMB Application for general license, additional fees for fingerprinting & self-query of \$38.50 & \$5.00, respectively.

Of the students who completed this program within normal time, the typical graduate leaves with \$9,400.00 of debt.
